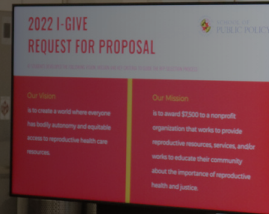

## What should faculty know?

- Any courses previously taken as I-Series Courses will count toward the Big Question requirement.
- Any previously approved I-Series Courses will remain approved as Big Question Courses.
- In the Schedule of Classes, the course code is still SCIS.

## Why the change?

The simple answer is that no one knows what "I-Series" means.

**All of these courses are centered around a complex question for which there is no simple, singular answer.** The name Big Question will do a better job of communicating the thread that is shared among this suite of courses.
