
I-Series Courses are now...

Big Question Courses!

What should I know?



- Any courses previously taken as I-Series Courses will count toward the Big Question requirement.
- Any previously approved I-Series
 Courses will remain approved as Big
 Question courses without any action required.
- In the Schedule of Classes, the course code is still SCIS.

The requirements are still...

6 CREDITS | 2 COURSES

Why the change?

The simple answer is that no one knows what "I-Series" meant. All of these courses are centered around a complex question for which there is no simple, singular answer.
